> SEC permanent evaluation (Tyler Pitts)

- → Summer Orientation
 - Gave speech on sustainability
 - conducted waste prevention and composting
 - canvas bags
 - provided info on transportation alternatives
- → General Gatherings
 - 30-40 students
 - PICA/FoCAN coordination
- → CSSC Convergence
 - 400 attendees
 - panel discussions, keynote speakers

> SEC Earth Summit (Toshi Barks, others)

- → Breakout groups were enthusiastic and successful
- → World Café held with students and admin
- → Blueprint committee should draft copy of new BP by next CSC meeting; needs 5 minutes
- → Last year expenditures \$26,000
- \rightarrow This year expenditures ~\$13,516-\$15,000
 - Scaled back on catered lunch
 - Less on speakers
 - Free room booking
- → Time-line being set for next year's coordinator

> FSWG (Tim Galarneau, others—in fruit and veggie costumes!)

- → OPERS fall festival
 - Helped host sustainability tent with other orgs
- → Dining hall real food events expanding
- → Campus harvest festival: Highlights seasonal crops throughout the year
- → Banana slugs for animals: PETA/veggie group coordination
 - Meatless Mondays at one dining hall each week
- → Speaker nights
 - Anna LaPay about food systems and planet impact
 - Janet Poppendieck with Sam Farr helping Reauthorization of Childhood Nutrition Act
 - Jennifer Johnson and Irwin Thomas youth-oriented food system music presentation
- → CSSC Fall convergence food systems workshop

- Discussed history of campus food system
- Discussed what UCSC and other campuses have accomplished
- → Coordinated with Crown/Merrill and College eight dining halls with local organic college nights, reaching 800 students
- → Strawberry taste tests with 80 attendees (will run two more)
- → Strengthening the Roots Convergence
 - Main organizing body for food activists to engage at UCSC
 - Workshops (permaculture, etc)
 - Classroom education to share what UCSC has accomplished
 - Discussion, powerpoint, etc
- → Food systems learning journeys
- → Bike to work, berry farms, Wilder Ranch farm
- → Work with OPERS in Spring Break trip to New Mexico
- → 10,000 Campus Food Guides
 - Inform students about local food and volunteering opportunities
 - New design coming out with 13,000 copies
 - Should come out in orientation bags
- → Dining hall assessment
 - How much food is local, processed, etc
 - Results due soon
- → Trying to get a grant for composting dining hall waste
 - Applied to EPA P3 program
 - Should be submitted next year
- → If ballot measure passes, FSWG might be able to to be weened off CSC

FoCAN (Danny Fuentes and Alex Martinez)

- → Next year marketing coordinator position in process of hiring
 - \$10 per hour, 14-16 hours per week
- → Supported dining hall outreach efforts and coffee marketing
- → Helped build other student orgs related to social justice
- → Helped organize leadership team and charter of FoCAN
- → Helped student volunteers develop campaign experience
- → Winter Intercambio
 - Logistical support
 - Translating during event
- → Building and utilizing bike power generator
- → Helped coordinate student internships abroad from other student orgs
- → helped FoCAN participate in Strengthening the Roots, other conferences held at

UCSC

- → Coffee, tabling, outreach
 - 100-300 students reached
- → Danny has utilized experience in generating interest through individual connections
- → FoCAN Should send CSC copy of charter after it is ratified by the group
- → Marketing coordinator position in proposed Spring 2010 budget will help keep track of budgeting
- → Future steps by CSC
 - More updates to FoCAN by CSC (Monthly updates to all orgs by CSC?)
 - More formal communication than word-of-mouth
 - Coordinating with CSC and other orgs to fulfill all areas of Blueprint
 - Rating orgs in how they're (we're) achieving on topic areas
 - Quarterly updates by orgs to CSC? Orgs should be notified ahead of time

> ESLP (Henry Simmons)

- → student involvement:
 - 12 organizers
 - 30 facilitators
 - 270 students
- → Monday night lectures:
 - 9 lectures on 9 different topics
 - Environmental Education, Environmental Law, Resource Recycling, Trade Justice, and many others
- → ART projects:
 - building a composting system at Kresge Garden, a dorm building energy conservation contest, a waste prevention campaign, and many others
- → CRAFTs
 - classes on the informed consumer, creative writing, herbology, and more
- → ESLP Successes
 - largest class ever
 - each ART has a faculty mentor
 - completed carter
 - successful recruiting
 - new system for developing sponsoring facilitators for next year
 - events: 12 Grandmothers, ESLP Festival and Appreciation lunch
 - three retreats with SEC, CAN, PICA
